



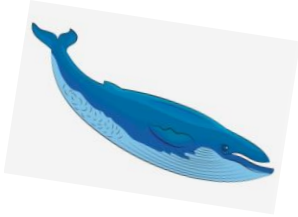

What will you learn?

You are now embarking on an exciting stage of your Primary School experience. Your teachers have been busy preparing your topics to make it an enjoyable year for you.

We will be looking at the texts of "The Stone Age Boy" and "The boy with the Bronze Axe" to enhance our writing and immerse us further into the topic. We will carry out some fieldwork using maps and compasses to learn more about what our village has to offer.
