Reminders....

- * Children should be wearing suitable, black, shoes to school and not trainers. It is important that they have trainers with them for PE or to change into if shoes get wet or muddy, but they must not be wearing them as school shoes.
- * We have had another complaint from a local resident about parents' parking. Please park considerately at the start and end of the day. Avoid blocking drive-ways and always leave access that may be required by emergency vehicles. Also, no one should be using the area in front of the gates to the staff carpark for dropping children off in the morning.
- * It's great to see the children bringing water bottles into school, but please make sure that they seal properly to reduce the risk of spillage, and use plastic bottles if possible. Some of the metal bottles are very heavy once filled.

Did you know that community pharmacies can now offer clinical appointments with medication available (if required) for **five clinical conditions** particularly relevant to school age children?


- Ear ache (children aged 1-17)
- Sore throat (over 5s)
- Infected insect bites (over 1s)
- Impetigo (over 1s)
- Sinusitis (over 12s)



Sore throat (Children and adults age 5 and up)

GP practices are busy and making an appointment with them is not always necessary!

When your child is ill with any of these conditions, head straight to your local community pharmacy where you can have a consultation with a trained clinical professional and receive advice, guidance and even medication if it's needed. Lets get your child on the road to recovery as soon as possible.
