In Science, we will look at the importance of nutrition and how animals and humans have nutritional needs, which need to be met.

In the spring term, we will be going back in time to the Ancient Egyptians with our topic, "Funky Pharaohs." We will be reading a range of texts to support this including: "The Pebble in my pocket" and "Egyptian Cinderella."

We shall finish off the year with the great and wonderful topic of "Under the Canopy." It's a lovely time of the year to get out and learn about the plants that grow in our world. We will look at the texts of "The Great Kapok Tree" and "The Jungle Challenge" to further our knowledge of the wonderful world we live in.
