

Parking


Unfortunately, we have received another complaint from a local resident regarding parking around school at the start and end of the school day.

Please be considerate when parking, and try to ensure that access for emergency vehicles is always possible as there are some vulnerable and disabled residents locally.

Wraysbury rules are Ready, Repectful, Safe and we would like to hope that our parents follow these too as a good example to the children.







That's because e-scooters are classed as motor vehicles in law. So, in theory, this means that you need an MOT, road tax and insurance to use one, however it isn't currently possible to register e-scooters in this way.

Privately owned e-scooters can only be used on private land, with the permission of the landowner.

You cannot use a privately owned e-scooter on the road, pavement or in a public space. If you do then you risk receiving a large fine, points on your driving licence and your e-scooter could be seized.

Some parts of the UK are running government trials of rental e-scooters. If you're over 18 and have a full or provisional driving licence, then you can use these on public roads and cycle paths.

Just check that your driving licence covers categories AM, A or B.
